OUR PAST:

The Child Abuse Prevention Center of NY, Inc. was established in 1982. Since then, the staff and volunteers at the Center have provided child abuse prevention and intervention services to over 6,000 families throughout Westchester County.

Our mission:

Reduce the incidence of child abuse and neglect and to help break the generational cycle of abuse while strengthening the parent-child relationship in the home. This is accomplished by utilizing trained community volunteers in an in-home intervention model.

Our Present:

Ms. W. and Mr. P. are young parents of an active 18 month old who are living in a homeless shelter. In addition to the instabilities in their lives, they are concerned about how active their child is and how often he says “no”, which they view as defiance. Through their work with a Parent Aide, the young couple began to understand age appropriate behaviors and positive play. Once they understood that saying “no” is a developmental stage, they were able to respond to their child in a more positive manner, reducing stress in the home and limiting the amount of “no’s”. They also found that they enjoyed playing positive games with him which in turn helped reduce his activity level.

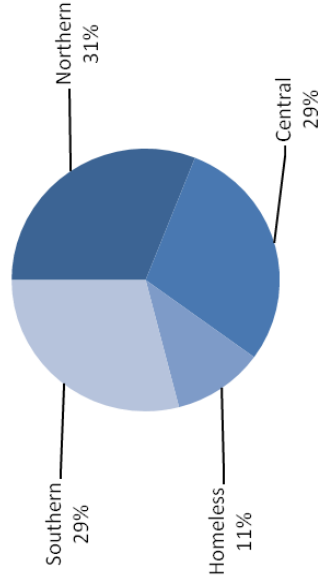
Our Future:

In 2011, the Center will:

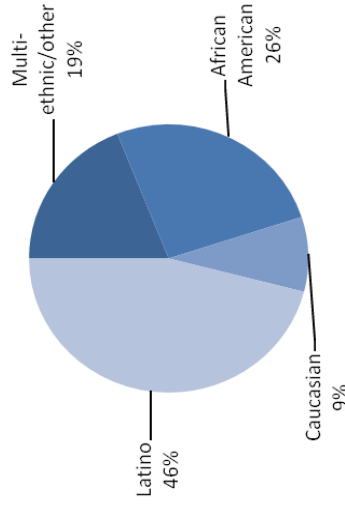
- Increase the focus on service provision

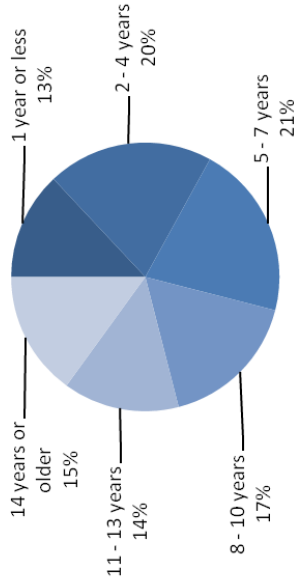
Geographically



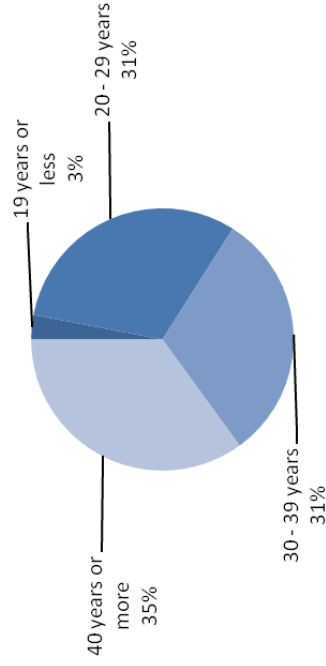
Race/Ethnicity
